Henffordd Gardens is an Enhanced Living Scheme, which offers flexible support for people with dementia and cognitive impairment, over the age of 50.

The scheme provides a radical shift in the delivery of care and support, with a real emphasis on independence. The scheme aims to help maintain a better quality of life.

Centred around 30 high quality apartments, in a prime Hereford city location, the scheme provides:

- Accessible accommodation
- Individually tailored care and support packages
- The very latest assistive technology
- On-site concierge
- Wi-fi and the latest digital technology

Care & Support

Henffordd Gardens enables us to provide individually tailored care and support packages within a safe and secure environment, whilst promoting independence.

Each tenant has a person-centred care package of 10 hours or more per week, delivered by our in-house care and support team. These care

packages are regularly reviewed, to ensure that physical and mental needs are being met. Our teams work closely with Social Workers, Occupational Therapists, Physiotherapists and other professionals to help provide a seamless and inclusive care and support service.

Concierge

There is an on-site concierge team working every day between 8am – 8pm. The team provide intensive housing management support which can include, but is not restricted to:

- Helping with letters or paperwork
- · Giving budgeting or benefit advice
- Assisting with access to local activities
- Sign-posting to other services
- Responding to Careline alarm calls

Telecare Technology

Henffordd Gardens uses fully integrated assistive technologies to provide full support to its tenants. Through the use of the latest Telehealth and Telecare technologies this ensures that they are given a secure home for life.

All of the apartments are fully equipped with smoke and heat detectors, a range of Careline alarms and support

systems. These can be used to alert colleagues to any issues or to summon assistance in an emergency. All new tenants are given an assessment to identify any additional Telecare equipment requirements and this forms an integral part of their care and support package.

Social Inclusion

The scheme promotes independence and social inclusion is an important feature. On-site there are many communal rooms and garden areas where tenants can chat, relax or just feel part of a community. There is also an on-site Café bistro open to tenants

and the wider community, with free wi-fi access and a computer room.


The team at Henforrdd Gardens also run activities such as crafts and singing, with all tenants welcome.
